



LETTER FROM THE CHAIR & CEO

On behalf of our Board of Directors, congratulations to all our HAVAN members and staff on a very successful year. It has been an honour to have served as the Board Chair of the Homebuilders Association of Vancouver (HAVAN) in 2023.

I would like to thank the staff at HAVAN for a great year and congratulate them for their many achievements in 2023. The staff at HAVAN continue to work tirelessly to support our association's many initiatives which grow our brand and allow us to remain a trusted resource for our 1,100 plus members and other industry stakeholders. HAVAN hosted many sold out events such as the Municipal Dinner, Legends of Housing (Trailblazers) Dinner, the HAVAN Awards Gala and Reception, Members Expo, and our Fall Classic Golf Tournament in addition to many other networking events which were all extremely successful and well attended.

As your Chair, I was fortunate to participate in many of these activities and events and thoroughly enjoyed connecting with our members. In addition, I also enjoyed participating in our networking events, board meetings, committee meetings, and travelling to represent HAVAN at both Provincial and National meetings.

Our feature event, the HAVAN Awards for Housing Excellence Gala at the JW Marriott Parq Hotel saw over 550 guests attend and celebrate a wonderful evening. With special guest Minister of Housing Ravi Kahlon in attendance, he provided some well received remarks on streamlining process and amplifying housing supply that resonated strongly with our members.

The 25th annual Fall Classic Golf Tournament in September at Swaneset Bay Resort &

Country Club, hosted 312 golfers, and 400 banquet attendees including volunteers and staff. It should be noted that the tournament's Live and Silent Auction raised \$10,000 to fund BCIT student scholarships for the School of Construction and the Environment.

HAVAN supported many charitable and educational initiatives in 2023, including the annual Coats for Kids campaign, which once again warmed the hearts of people in many ways and successfully raised \$11,000. We are also proud that HAVAN's Women's Council donated \$10,000 in support of BCIT's new ACE program, a new initiative for 2023. In addition, the "Let's Build a Career" campaign Online Expo hosting 400 participants and marketing campaign (with 3M views) focused on encouraging women and visible minorities to consider a career in construction.

Our education offerings continue to advance industry knowledge and construction technology, offering fresh and timely content, and providing the opportunity for members to earn their CPD points. Topics included energy efficient construction, business development, understanding of the Energy Step Code in addition to an engaging presentation on the importance of supporting mental health in the construction industry by Corey Hirsch and a panel of speakers including representatives from *WorkSafeBC, Movember.com, UBC*, and *Kuhn LLP*.

HAVAN'S GR staff were extremely busy in 2023 advocating and successfully engaging with all levels of government to move the industry forward through our many initiatives.

2022-2023 PRIORITIES & HIGHLIGHTS

The 2022/2023 fiscal saw HAVAN welcome 175 new members and a new member rate up 27% over last year, with a renewal level of 90%. Membership is comprised of 39% builder/developers, 18% renovators, and 43% product/services.


CANADIAN HOME BUILDERS' ASSOCIATION (NATIONAL)




